SUBJECT: Report of Enrollment (Head Count)

Beginning with the fall semester 1981 the University instituted the policy of up-dating class level on the basis of 30, 60, 90 hours passed. Previously this was done on the basis of 24, 56, 86. This change has resulted in the shifting of a large number of students from one class to another. Figures reported for Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior head count for the fall semester 1981 are not comparable to those reported in previous years.
