

SUBJECT: Summer Session 2 Enrollment Report

Attached is the required enrollment report for Summer Session 2, 1989.

I have prepared a second copy of the report which compares 1989 with 1988; however, caution must be exercised in using such comparisons. In 1989, all of the short-courses, workshops, and non-standard calendar courses are offered in our "Session 4." All of these enrollments are included in the "Summer 2" enrollment report. In 1988, some of the enrollments for non-standard calendar courses were embedded in "Summer 1" and others in "Summer 2."

I am pleased to tell you that the Summer 1 enrollment report showed an enrollment increase over 1988 of 3.3%, the Summer 2 enrollment report (attached) indicates an enrollment increase over 1988 of 15.2%, and the "unduplicated" headcount enrollment for all of summer is 12.0% (595 students) ahead of the same relative time for Summer, 1988. If you have questions regarding the attached report, please let me know.
