Attached is a preliminary Summer I, 1987 enrollment report. This report is preliminary since it counts students enrolled in sessions 1, 3 and 9 as of Friday, June 12, 1987. The DHE report for Summer I, 1987 will include enrollments in sessions 1, 3, 4, 5, and 9 and will be based upon enrollments the night of June 19, 1987. (The change in reporting has been done according to instructions from E. F. Buckley, Director of Institutional Research.) At the time the official DHE enrollment counts are generated, I will prepare the official enrollment report based upon that data (we need to be careful in comparing that data to Summer I for 1986).

Because of the change in DHE dates and the terms for which data is included, comparisons are, at best, cumbersome. I have, however, attached a copy of the 1986 Summer I report prepared by Nancy Talburt which included only sessions 1 and 3. The data from that report and the data reflected on the "preliminary report" are probably the most comparable of the summer (i.e., until summer is completed). To aid in making comparisons, I have also attached "Preliminary Report B" which is the same as the preliminary report except that I have added a column which indicates the percent change, by category, from 1986.

The story of enrollment, as it now appears, is anything but positive. While the attached reports reflect a headcount decrease of about 18% (for now), we have approximately 4,800 different individuals currently enrolled and paid for some session of the summer. This 4,800 needs to be compared to the 5,842 non-duplicative headcount of Summer, 1986. If we register about 500 students during arena registration for Summer II, as we did last year, then the total number of students for summer will be about 5,300, a decrease of just under 10% from last year (that's better than the 18% we now face).

It is important that studies be undertaken to determine the various attributes and causes of the decrease in enrollment. Many of us firmly believe that the current summer calendar has had a significant and detrimental impact on enrollment since the University started the summer session before the public schools were out (there were numerous complaints from public school teachers about this) and before many other colleges and universities had completed the spring semester.
