SUBJECT: Summer Session 1 Enrollment Report

---

Attached is the required enrollment report for Summer Session 1, 1989. I regret that the report is late; however, there was a significant problem with OASIS as the DHE reports were being generated. The problem was corrected this past week-end after awaiting technical adjustments to OASIS by the University of Windsor.

I have prepared a second copy of the report which compares 1989 with 1988; however caution must be exercised in using such comparisons. In 1989, all of the short-courses workshops, and non-standard calendar courses are offered in our "Session 4." All of these enrollments will be included in the "Summer 2" enrollment report. In 1988, some of the enrollments for non-standard calendar courses were embedded in "Summer 1" and others in "Summer 2." The enrollments counted in the 1989 report are those in the first five-week session, the ten-week session, and those in the inter-session. Since nearly all of the inter-session students also enrolled in either the first five-week or ten-week sessions, the actual headcount is only slightly increased by including the inter-session students.

I anticipate that the real increase in enrollment will be noted when the "Summer 2" enrollment report is prepared. The "Summer 2" report will include those students in the second five-week session as well as all of the students in the other non-standard sessions (the short-courses, workshops, law, and architecture). As you know and at this point in time, the "unduplicated" headcount enrollment for all of summer is about 14% (more than 600 students) ahead of the same relative time for Summer, 1988.


